Read Me First

Direct Internet allows users with data capable Iridium phone (or LBT) and computer to access the Internet through Iridium Gateway. Based on your operating system, you would have downloaded one of the following packages: Direct Internet for Windows or Direct Internet for MAC.

Windows OS package includes the following files:

- Read Me First
- Iridium Direct Internet 3 Installer for Windows
- MODEM folder
- VCOMPORT folder
- Iridium 9555 Data Services Manual
- Iridium Direct Internet User Manual for Windows
- Iridium Direct Internet 3 Install Guide for Windows 7

- Iridium Direct Internet 3 Install Guide for Windows XP

MAC OS package includes the following files:

If you have Windows OS and are using the Iridium 9555 as the modem, please follow the directions below.

Make sure your PC is powered on and connected to the Iridium 9555 with a USB mini cable. The Iridium 9555 phone should also be turned on and receiving a signal.

- 1) Print out “Iridium 9555 Data Services Manual”. This contains instructions on how to install USB drivers on your PC for the Iridium 9555 (if you are using Iridium 9555 as the modem). The drivers for the Iridium 9555 can be found in the VCOMPORT folder.



- 2) Print out the “Direct Internet 3 Installer Guide” which will help guide you through the installation process. For Windows, there is a separate guide for Windows 7, XP and Vista. Please print out the appropriate installation guide.
- 3) Double click the “Iridium Direct Internet 3 Installer” file to start the installation process.

For Mac OS, you will need to do the following:

- 1) Print out the “Direct Internet 3 Installer Guide for Mac” which will help guide you through the installation process.
- 2) Double click the “Iridium Direct Internet 3 Installer” file to start the installation process.

With Direct Internet installed, you are ready to send emails and browse the internet. Below are a few tips to help optimize your user experience.

Emails:

For emails, it is recommended that you use a client- based email software instead of a web-based software. For example, Mozilla Thunderbird is preferred over Windows Live Hotmail. Other recommendations are listed below.
